Based Chapter 4 of the Michigan Plumbing Code 2009 (MPC 2009) the store and building is required to have 2 toilet rooms, one for men and one for women. Exception: If the total occupant load (customers and employees) does not exceed 15 at any given time the owner can submit a notarized affidavit with supporting documentation for review and approval by the building department/plumbing inspector. The plumbing affidavit shall include the following:

- A) A statement that says the total numbers of employees and customers will never exceed 15 at any given time. A letter that outlines/lists the total occupant load for employees and the total occupant load for customer/visitor shall be submitted as supporting documentation. The supporting documentation shall include/address the following conditions:
 - 1) Are there multiple shifts?
 - 2) Do the shifts overlap?
 - 3) Is your information based on the busiest time?
 - 4) Do you have another operation somewhere that you can use as an example?
 - 5) Projected number of customers.
 - 6) Do the customers get out of their cars for any of the services or to pay?
- B) The affidavit shall include a statement that says that a second toilet room will be added if the occupant ever exceeds 15.
